

VISIT TO INTERNATIONAL BOMBER COMMAND CENTRE

FRIDAY 5TH APRIL 2019 – 10.30 A.M

Following the most interesting and enlightening talk by IBCC volunteer Robert Ankersen, at January's Meeting, a visit to the International Bomber Command Centre has been arranged for 5th April 2019.

Members should meet at the IBCC car park just before 10.30 a.m. ready for an introductory talk and a guided tour of the Peace Gardens, Memorial Spire and Walls. This takes 3/4 – 1 hour. We will then be led into the Chadwick Centre, which houses exhibition galleries with interactive displays and exhibits. Here the guided tour ends and we can wander and explore at our leisure, perhaps stopping for lunch at the Hub Café, which offers a locally sourced selection of tempting treats and meals.

If our party exceeds 20, the cost for the visit is £6.50 per person. This is to be paid in advance. To secure your place, we ask that a CHEQUE in the sum of £6.50, payable to LINDSEY U3A, is given to us at the 7th March Meeting. The Booking Form will be in the Welton Room from 7th February.

In line with many national, charity run heritage sites, the IBCC has to charge for parking to ensure that ongoing maintenance to the grounds is funded. The car parking charge is £3 all day, payable at the ticket machine. Car-sharing is recommended. For staffing purposes in the Hub Café, an idea of the number of members requiring lunch/refreshments has been requested.
